CHAMPIONSHIP RULES

1. This competition is registered with SASCHDI and will be conducted under the rules and conditions as set down by SOBHD and as adopted by ABHDI.
2. Teachers, interested parties or any other unauthorised person must not communicate with Judges during the Championships. All enquiries to the official table.
3. A competitor who has taken part in any so called Championship not recognised by the Board or any person who has acted as a judge at such an event, shall be ineligible to compete or judge in any recognised Championship or Competition under SOBHD rules until given permission to do so by the Board. Such permission may be withheld for as long as a Board may decide.
4. According to SOBHD rules, there must be at least six entries in advance of the competition date, and at least six of these must take part on the day for the Championship to go ahead. In the event of less than six competitors dancing in any one championship, section will be danced but the Championship will not be recognised. No certificate, trophy or sash will be presented, but individual prize money will be paid.
5. Competitors do not have to remain in the marshalling area but must return for the correct order of ballot. The onus is on the competitor to return in time for the correct order of ballot. (*ABHDI Technical 5/10/85 P 3 ratified ABHDI 6/10/85 P 8*).
6. Any complaint made by an individual against the organisation or adjudication of an event, must be made in writing giving the complainants full name and address, and shall be lodged with the Organiser, if possible, on the day of the event, certainly not later than 48 hours after the event. Such complaint to be accompanied by a fee as determined by the ABHDI which is refundable if protest upheld.
7. All placegetters in Championships are to be dressed in **KILT** for trophy presentation.
8. Judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
9.
 - a) With the advent of electronic recording equipment there be no restrictions on the usage of electronic recording equipment provided permission is obtained from the organisers and judges and it does not interfere with the smooth organisation of the competition/championship or in any way restrict the view of the judge/s.
 - b) That judges and organisers should bear in mind that the judge's decision is final and cannot be subjected to an electronic recording equipment replay.

ALL competitors must be modestly attired at all times; a T-shirt, or similar must be worn if vest or jacket is removed.

STEPS AS SET BY THE S.O.B.H.D.

COMPETITION RULES

1. **The organiser reserves the right to alter or amend the program.**
2. Techniques and steps as set by Scottish Official rules.
3. ALL COMPETITORS are required to register with the appropriate State/Regional Committee.
4. **Dancers must be REGISTERED AND FINANCIAL at the date of close of competition entries.**
5. Dancer's age taken as at the date of competition. Competitors must dance in their own age group only and compete entirely at their own risk.
6. **Competitors must be in attendance when called or forfeit the right to dance.**
7. When more than 1 competition is registered in the one day at the one venue, competition organisers must abide by the 8 dance rule.
8. **Title Sections must have at least 3 competitors or section will revert to an aggregate.**
9. Protest rule (as per SOBHDI Constitution) – any complaint made by an individual against the organisation or adjudication of an event must be made in writing giving the complainant's full name and address and shall be lodged with the organizer if possible on the day of the event and certainly no later than 48 hours after the event. Such complaint must be accompanied by a deposit, the amount to be set by the Board. The deposit shall be returned should the complaint be upheld. If within 7 days of lodging such a complaint, the complainant has received no satisfaction from the organiser, then the complainant may refer the matter to the Honourable Secretary of the Board.
10. **No responsibility will be taken for any lost property, injuries or any accident. This includes any person present at the competition as well as the dancers.**
11. The Organiser has the right to enforce Rule 1(f), page 28D Judges, SOBHDI Rules and Regulations, which reads, "provided due prominence is given to the fact in the programme or in a brochure by the organiser, then during the course of the competition the comportment of the competitors may come under the jurisdiction of the judges, not only whilst dancing, but also when entering or leaving the platform and whilst waiting for the dance to start. Any unseemly behaviour on the part of the competitor or any misdemeanour likely to upset the decorum of the proceedings may be penalised by the judges and could lead to disqualification, but a full report of any such conduct on the part of a competitor must be submitted by the judges to the organiser."
12. **No refunds** will be given unless the event is cancelled. The final decision will be at the discretion of the organiser.

26. CHOREOGRAPHY

The Choreography section is a registered competition using registered Judges and danced in conjunction with a registered competition. (ABHDI Tech 6/10/01 P9)

Solo and duo sections may be conducted. (ABHDI Tech 6/10/01 P9)

The rules apply to groups of three or more dancers. (ABHDI Tech 6/10/01 P9)

Dancers cards should not be stamped as Premier and Pre-Premier dancers may compete in the same group. (ABHDI Tech 6/10/01 P9)

The following rules were agreed and passed at an SOBHD Meeting held on 1 October 2000 and will come into operation as from 1 January 2001.

1. A group choreography competition is open to registered dancers, the age groups to be set by the organiser.
2. Content should consist primarily of movements from Highland, National, Hornpipe and Jig books.
3. A maximum of five minutes' time limit should be set to include entrance and exit of competitors and setting up and removal of props.
4. Teams may use props during their performance, either static or non-static, but live animals are not permitted.
5. A minimum of three and a maximum number to be set by the organiser.
6. Music may be live or pre-recorded and may include vocal or percussion selections, but in all cases must be predominantly Scottish or Celtic in style. Music may be provided by the competition organiser.
7. Costumes must follow the theme and content.
8. Judges must be from the current SOBHD, ABHDI or OBHD) SA Judges Panel. The number of Judges must be one or three to comply with the current scrutineering system. A total mark should be awarded. No separate prizes for costumes etc.
9. Teams should consist of:
 - a) one school only
 - b) more than one school, in which case, the teacher/choreographer must abide by the three month teaching/judging rule.

The following proposition was passed at the SOBHD meeting on Saturday 19th November and comes into effect on 1st January 2017:

Choreography may be classified as either:

- a) Themed – defined as the main idea on which the dance is based and may be set by the organiser**
- b) Choreographed Broadwords or Reel**
- c) Set-piece – Choreographed dance to a piece of music set by the organiser**
- d) Open – this may include a) Themed or b) Choreographed Broadsword or Reel or a dance which is an interpretation of the music with no theme.**

The classification of choreography is at the discretion of the organiser and must be pre-advertised. Judges of the event must be furnished with same criteria that is issued to teachers and choreographers prior to judging the event.
